4. A national and first runner-up will be selected. The winner and his/her spouse will receive \$750 towards expenses for attending the 2017 annual meeting of the American Guernsey Association and the Eugene Harding Memorial Award, in addition to pictures and publicity.
5. The first runner-up will receive \$200 to assist with travel expenses if he/she attends the 2017 annual meeting of the AGA.
6. This competition is to acknowledge the progressive attitude of young Guernsey breeders and considers their successes with the dairy businesses and farming operations.
