

The Janice Keene Award for Youth Participation at National Convention

Janice Keene served as editor of the *Guernsey Breeders' Journal* from 1982 to 1986. When she left to pursue her Master's degree at The Ohio State University, she was presented with a "Proof" Eustis Model Guernsey. In 2024, Keene donated this cow to be auctioned to create a fund to sponsor awards to assist youth in attending AGA National Conventions. Keene attended national breed conventions as a junior member and values the connections, learning and camaraderie that conventions provide for people of all ages. She is grateful for her time serving Guernsey breeders and for the opportunity to give back to the Guernsey breed in this one-of-a-kind way. In 2025, additional items donated by past Executive Secretary Bernie Heisner will also be auctioned to benefit this fund.

This award will be given annually in April to an American Guernsey Youth Association member to travel to and participate in the National Guernsey Convention and concurrent youth contests. The award is \$500 to be presented at the Youth Award Ceremony at the National Guernsey Convention.

Criteria

The award will be given to the applicant considered by the Janice Keene Award Committee to be the most deserving based upon the evaluation of the applicant's enthusiasm for participation in youth contests, desire to travel and promote the breed, and the impact such award would have on the youth's ability to participate.

Qualifications

1. The applicant must be a Junior Member of the American Guernsey Association.
2. Applicants under 18 years old as of July 1 of the award year must include the attached Statement of Parent/Guardian Approval as well as designate an adult chaperone who will attend the National Convention (see the statement for details).
3. Applicants must attend the National Guernsey Convention in the award year, participate in at least one in-person contest, attend the Youth Award ceremony and any other youth events that are part of the convention schedule.
4. The application, with all supporting materials, must be postmarked or emailed no later than March 31. No late applications will be accepted.
